

Starting at 30 $^{\circ}$ F plot isotherms every 10 $^{\circ}$ F. For each station the temperature is recorded in the upper left. For example, it was 57 $^{\circ}$ F in Las Vegas at 1500 Z (7AM PST) on March 26 2003. Using different colors color in the space between 30 $^{\circ}$ F and 40 $^{\circ}$ F, 40 $^{\circ}$ F and 50 $^{\circ}$ F, to make your map look like one you'd see in a weather report in USA Today.
