- 1. Use the SELECT A COUNTRY OR LOCATION pop-up menu to choose your team's country.
- 2. Click on PEOPLE AND SOCIETY tab.
- 3. Use the Population value for your initial population.
- 4. Use the Birth Rate, Death Rate, and Net Migration Rate data to build the growth for a simple exponential model.
- 5. Produce a good graph of your model.
- 6. Predict your country's population for the next five years.
- 7. Discuss whether the predictions are reasonable or not and why.
- 8. What factors could change that would affect your model?
- 9. Determine whether the country's resources will be adequate to your projection of the population growth.
