

- \$1000. Scholarship
 - paid by the Geology Department after successful completion of the Internship
- Requirements set by employer (see individual ads)
 - Minimum: GEOL 101, 201, 380
 - Maximum: GEOL 303A, 335, chemistry

summer 2008

- Applications due late March to mid-April
 - on-line scholarship application
 - cover letter
 - essay
 - letter from faculty
- Applications submitted to Geology Dept.
- Interviews in April
- Work starting in May to July
