


The Water Cycle Reservoirs and Fluxes



The diagram above represents Earth's seven reservoirs of water (gray rectangles) and the fluxes that interconnect them (labeled arrows). The processes that drive the fluxes (evaporation; precipitation; condensation; transpiration; freezing; melting; etc.) are not included in the diagram.

- Units for reservoirs are km^3
- Units for flux values are $km^3/year$
- Fluxes for the thin arrows without values are less than one $km^3/year$
