AE Improving Application Exercises

Consider the draft Application Exercise(AE) from the AE Library that is under development for the new Starting Point module on TBL.

Examine the Application Exercise Rubric carefully, then read the AE draft.

- 1. Individually, rate the draft AE on each of the categories in the rubric by assigning an Excellent (E), Needs Minor Revision (G), or Needs Major Revision (N) in the form provided.
- 2. As a team, rate the draft AE on each of the categories in the rubric.
- 3. As is the case with most of the AE drafts in the library, this one contains scanty teaching notes. Revise the teaching notes to attain E status in categories 5 and 6 of the rubric. (Note: in addition to the description in the rubric, it has been suggested that teaching notes should provide guidance about how to make each AE easier for lower-level classes and harder for higher-level classes. Feel free to add this information to the notes as well.)
- 4. When you are ready to report your final edits, indicate your suggested revisions to the teaching notes on the poster as neatly as you can.
- 5. Tape your team's completed rubric for the AE and your marked-up AE to the wall nearest your work table.
