HAZARD Mauna Loa has just erupted and there is the potential for lava flow inundation of your location.	Move one position backwards to avoid the lava flow path!
HAZARD High volcanic gases and shifting trade winds have made your current location hazardous with heavy Vog.	Move one position backwards to avoid heavy Vog concentrations!
HAZARD A recent lava flow has cut off access to the road in front of you.	Remain in current location until road is clear, or detour is established!
HAZARD A large and persistent earthquake is occurring under the Big Island. The fear of tsunami is low, but the potential for landslides in high.	Move one position backwards to avoid heavy landslides.
