

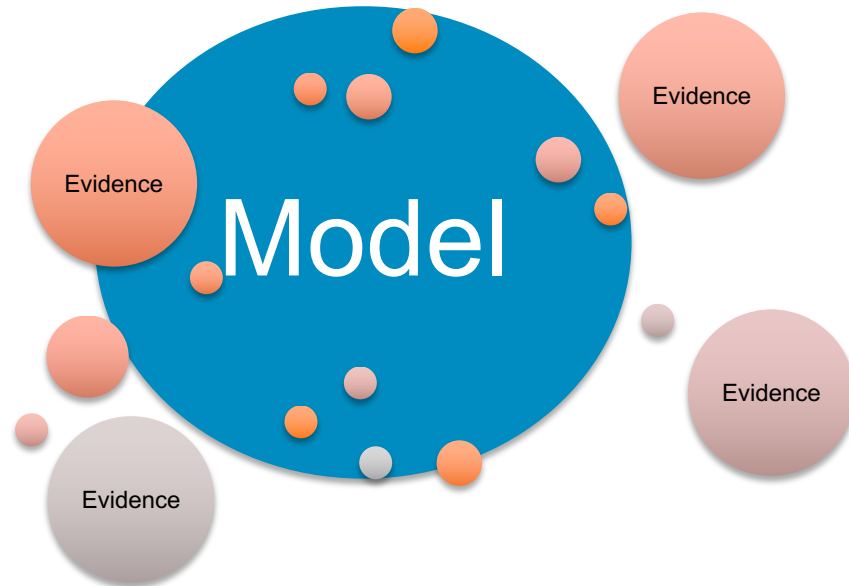

- Eight (or more) lines of evidence



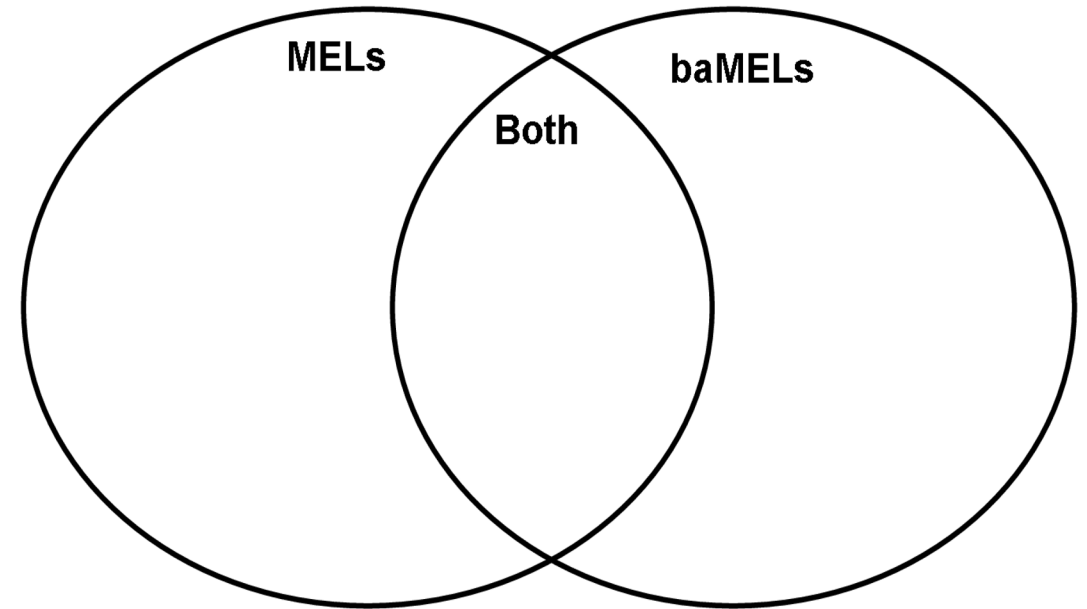
MELs and baMELs: Instructional Differences?

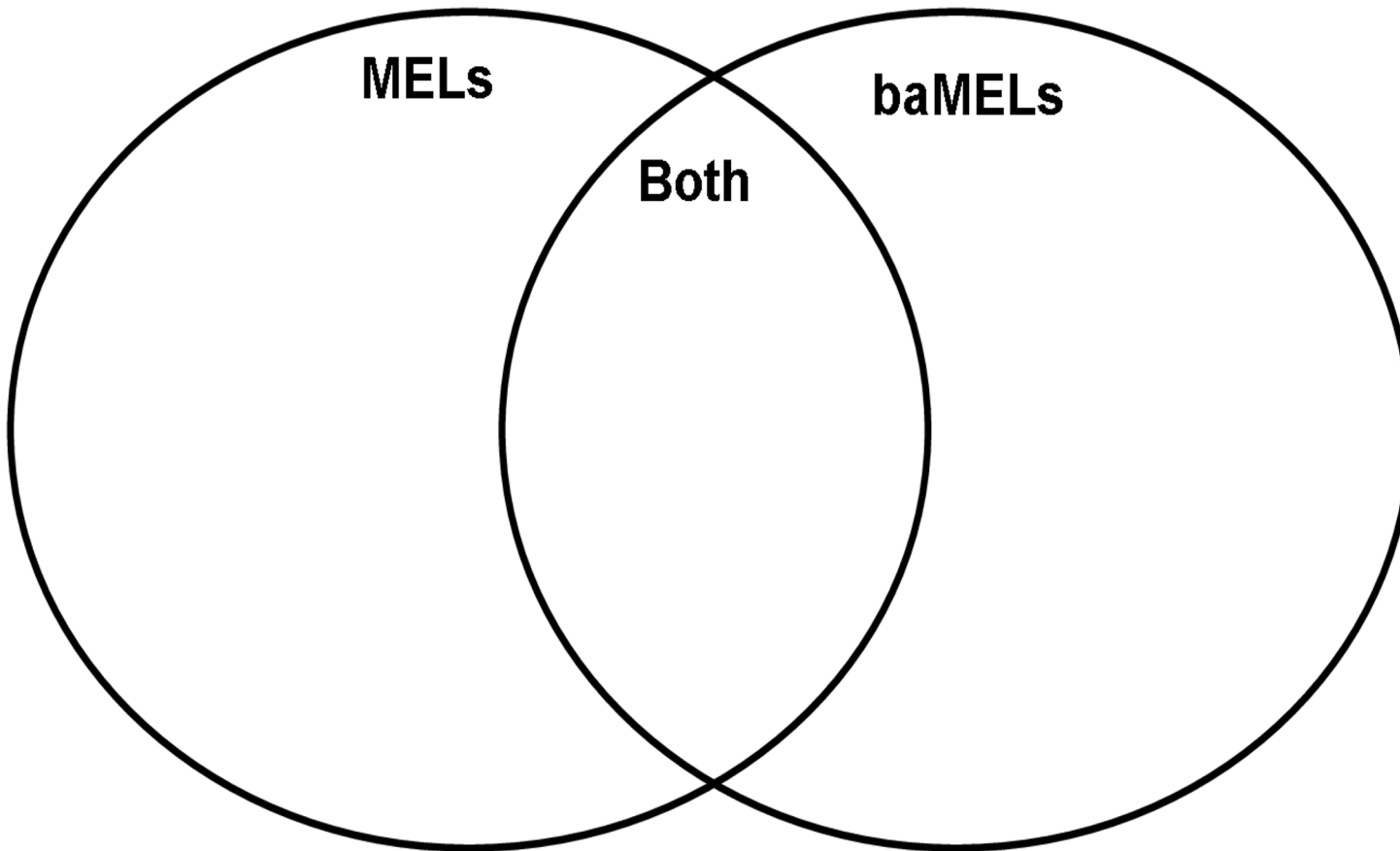
