MEL Project Google Folder README

What is in this folder?

This Google Drive folder contains MEL resource documents in the Google formats. In order to maximize the flexibility of our activities, the MEL Project Team wanted to make more resources compatible with virtual settings. We have made our MEL scaffolds available in Google formats, so that they can be copied, modified, and uploaded more easily on a variety of platforms and devices. Please note that to access all the materials for each MEL scaffold, you will need a Google account.

These Google formats are the *same as the paper-based materials* provided on the associated MEL Project resource webpages. You may want to modify the documents to better suit your course format, such as providing instructions for online completion.

How do I modify a document?

This Google Drive folder is set as "View Only," so it cannot be modified directly. You will first need to *save a copy* of the document, then edit the copy. To save a copy to your Google Drive, sign into your Google account, open the document, and select File → "Make a copy" and save it to your Google Drive.

Can I request edit access on a document?

No. Please do not click "Request Edit Access" on the original document. Instead, make a copy of the document following the directions above, then edit your copy.

Are there restrictions on modifying/distributing the documents?

All materials are freely available under a <u>Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike license</u>. You may reuse these materials for non-commercial purposes as long as you provide attribution and offer any derivative works under a similar license.
