Peanut Policy Case**

Please read the attached material very carefully and jot down answers to the following questions. We will be doing more analytical work with this material in class on Friday, September 24.

1. What is (was) the goal of the government's peanut program?
2. What are the elements of the government policy? That is, of what does the peanut program consist?
4. The reporter interviewed members of three groups concerned with the peanut program. What groups do these people represent? Briefly summarize each group's point of view, and explain why they feel they way they do.
5. How do you think the people of Senegal, a major peanut growing country, view the U.S. peanut program?
