



Truman (USA), Churchill (Great Britain) and Chiang kai-shek (Nationalist China) say “By next year we can raise 3 million troops.” The books lying in front of Soviet and Chinese heroes are entitled “History of the Soviet People’s Patriotic War” (top) and “History of the People’s Liberation Army” (bottom.)






